

Short-term Intensive Course on Developing Yourself and Your Company

The aim of the course is to transfer modern and practice-oriented skills of problem recognition, assessment of the situation, within clarification of expectations (PEST, SWOT analyses). For finding the causes of the problem different methods are applied (Ishikawa, Pareto analyses, 8D report). To find the resolution, feasibility studies are made including the costs, the formulation of the objectives and a business plan. During the feasibility study the quantitative and qualitative indicators are created with the help of the SMART methodology. In the project a Gantt-diagram is established to define the main and sub-activities and to plan the human, technical and financial resources. After all, the risk analyses are carried out to determine the resources and to secure the quality (FMEA, ISO 9001). When the expected results are not succeed, a PDCA is made and lean management system is applied.
